STUDY PROGRAMME FORESTRY AND HUNTING

If you want to gain a quality, good theoretical and practical knowledge in the field of forestry and hunting, if you want to do your work placement abroad, if you want to join those who are winning at the European championships or maybe just enjoy a vibrant and diverse study period, then the study of forestry and hunting is the right choice, which will provide you with the skills necessary to enter the labour market.

How many students will be admitted this year? 50 enrolment places for full and part-time studies respectively, are available in this academic year.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the study programme is allowed to candidates who have passed a final examination in any upper secondary school (including vocational-technical programmes), or gimnazija (general upper secondary school), vocational course or any other programme to acquire upper secondary education.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

You apply by using the online application form available at www.vss-ce.com/vps. A completed enrolment application form must be printed, signed and sent by registered post, with all the supplemental documents, by the application deadline set by the call for enrolment of the Higher Vocational College Postojna, to the application services:

Only one application form can be sent, in which you can list, in preferential order, up to three study programmes according to your wishes.

PROGRAMME DURATION

The study is for the period of 2 years in duration and is valued at 120 credit points according to ECTS.

LOCATION

Lectures are held on the premises of the Higher Vocational College Postojna, at 2 Ljubljanska ulica, and in the laboratories in School Centre Postojna, at 2 Cesta v Staro vas, in Postojna.

PRACTICAL TRAINING

Every academic year comprises 400 hours of practical training in companies (10 weeks), which is organized with the help of the school. The programme is designed to follow the trends of modern times. Management, organization, planning and implementation of activities in the forestry and hunting are intertwined and integrated, which aims at a thoroughly educated and practically trained graduate of Forestry and Hunting. Content selection is included in the programme in the extent of 20 credits, which allows appropriate adjustment of graduates' competences according to their interests and is aligned with the needs of the labour market.

STUDY PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

Educate engineers with theoretical and practical knowledge in the field of forestry and hunting, gain and extend theoretical and practical knowledge about forestry and hunting, develop a responsible attitude towards quality assurance in the field of forestry and hunting.

VOCATIONAL SPECIFIC COMPETENCES

Production of silvicultural plans, participation in the elaboration of forest management plans for an economic unit, felling and skidding plans and hunting management plans, monitoring of the development of populations of wild animals of their compliance with forest biotope, monitoring and recording of the occurrence of rare fauna and flora and making suggestions for their protection in the wider forest area as well as outside the forest, surveillance of the zones in accordance with legislative and executive acts in the field of hunting and nature conservation, independent organization, coordination and management of the tasks in forestry companies, private properties and many others.
